

Conflict Minerals Sourcing Policy

To whom it may concerns,

As a social responsible company, LNI Swissgas is concerned about violence, conflicts and human rights violations that results from the sourcing of “Conflict minerals” originating in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (“DRC”) or an adjoining country, collectively defined as the “Covered Countries”.

“Conflict minerals” are defined by the SEC as columbite-tantalite (coltan), cassiterite, gold, wolframite, or their derivatives, which are limited to tantalum, tin, gold and tungsten.

As a purchaser of products containing gold, which is a 3TG mineral, we confirm our suppliers whose materials remain in our calibration products have set policies and measures on Conflict Minerals Rule and that the products or components supplied to us and containing conflict minerals are DRC conflict free.

We confirm they operate in accordance with the "OECD Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Supply Chains of Minerals from Conflict" that is audited on a regular basis by a 3rd party.

In this way, we confirm LNI Swissgas sources responsibly and complies with the Conflict Minerals Rule as under Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act was adopted by the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (“SEC”), adopted on August 22, 2012.

In the event where suppliers or subcontractors are found to not be in compliance with our Policy, we first intend to encourage them to source responsibly. We will then in case of failure re-evaluate our business relationship.
